The ordinance prohibits smoking in the following **Public Places**:

- Places of employment, indoor or outdoor
- Service areas, such as ATM lines and bus stops
- Recreational areas, including playgrounds, parks, sports fields, gardens, hiking paths, beaches, etc.
- Indoor and outdoor Dining Areas, with an exception for outdoor spaces at Bars that do not serve food, or for bars with outdoor spaces that have been serving food over the past 90 day period.
- Sidewalks adjacent to public or private schools
- Public Events, such as sports events, parades and fairs, including the Solano Stroll.
- On Solano Avenue

In **Multi Family Housing**, smoking is prohibited in common areas, both indoor and outdoor, although a landlord may designate an outdoor smoking area. Landlords are required to maintain a list of designated non-smoking and smoking units, including a floor plan that shows the designated smoking area. The list and plan is to be incorporated into the lease document signed by both landlord and tenant. A condominium seller is required to disclose whether smoking has been permitted in the unit and the smoking policies of the condominium complex.
