INFORMATION

ALBANY RESIDENTIAL TRASH SERVICES

Your trash is typically collected weekly in 20, 32, 64 or 96 gallon wheeled burgundy carts. Customers can decrease the size of their container to a 10 gallon micro can by calling Waste Management at (510) 613-8710. Note: the 10 gallon micro can does not have wheels and is available by application and approval. Call Waste Management at (510) 613-8710 for an application.



SCHEDULE & SET-OUT INFORMATION

- Wheel carts to street curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Residential collection will be provided Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Do not overload carts; lids must close. Overage fees may apply to overflowing carts.
- Place dry-cell household batteries in a sealed heavy duty plastic bag on top of your gray recycling cart.
- Place cell phones in a sealed heavy duty plastic bag on top of your gray recycling cart.
- For occasional extras, 30 gallon paper garden bags for yard trimmings and 32 gallon Bag-its for garbage may be purchased from Waste Management by calling (510) 613-8710. Paper gardening bags may also be found at many hardware stores.
- The standard cart size for recycling (gray cart) and organics (green cart) is a 64 gallon cart. Residents may increase cart size up to a 96 gallon cart at no additional charge. Contact Waste Management at (510) 613-8710 to increase your recycling or organics cart size. A fee applies for additional organics carts
- Holidays are Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. When a holiday falls on a weekday, pickup will be one day later for the rest of that week.

Bagged dry-cell household batteries go on top. Bagged old cellphones on top as well.

Curbside, set out used motor oil in a WM provided jug and used oil filters in a customer provided sealed plastic bag. Call (510) 613-8710 for jugs.

ON-CALL BULKY ITEM PICKUP

You Call, We'll Haul. Call (510) 613-8710 to schedule an individual pick up once per year at your convenience. A second bulky pick up appointment is available for the first 300 requests per year. Watch for guidelines to come.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

HHW Drop-off Center is located at 2100 East 7th St., Oakland.

HHW (i.e. Household hazardous waste such as paints, pesticides, fertilizers, propane tanks and cleaners) is not allowed in any of the trash, recycling or organics containers. For more information including acceptable items and hours, call (800) 606-6606 or visit www.household-hazwaste.org.



FREE HOLIDAY TREE-CYCLING PICKUP

Trees are picked up curbside during the month of January on your regular pickup day.

Only clean trees will be picked up: no "snow" flocking, stands or decorations. Trees must be cut to less than 5 feet tall.



FREE BATTERY COLLECTION

Household batteries (AAA, AA, B, C, D & small button batteries), including rechargeable and cell phone batteries, can be recycled. Place batteries in a clear plastic bag, seal shut & place on the top of the gray recyclables cart.



FREE CELL PHONE COLLECTION

Residential customers may now recycle cellular phones. Place old cell phones in a clear plastic bag, seal shut and place on top of the gray recyclables cart.



FREE USED MOTOR OIL & OIL FILTER COLLECTION

Call WMAC at (510) 613-8710 to request free used motor oil jugs and filter bags. Set out up to 3 jugs and 3 filters curbside for pick up on your regular collection day.

Only WM oil jugs & bags will be accepted for pickup.



COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHTS COLLECTION

It is illegal to place Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFLs) in any of your trash, recycling or organics containers. Beginning in early 2012, residents will be able place CFLs at the curb for collection. Watch for specific guidelines which will be mailed separately.



COMPOST GIVE-AWAY

Bagged compost will be available for distribution to residents annually. Watch for additional details to come.

MORE SERVICES



SENIOR CITIZEN RATE

A 20% discount on the monthly trash rate is available for residential customers that are sixty-two (62) years or older. Contact Waste Management at (510) 613-8710 to apply for the Senior Citizen Rate. Proof of age is required.



BACKYARD COLLECTION

Carts can be collected from backyards for an additional fee, or no fee for qualifying disabled individuals.
