SUBJECT: Gift to the City: Approval for Memorial Plaques Replacement by Albany Community Foundation and Albany FireFighters Association

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Accept the proposed Gift to City, with the provision that the city will be responsible for installation of the replacement plaques.

BACKGROUND

In January of 2008, the City received a proposal from the Albany Community Foundation to replace the two faded plaques at the Veterans Memorial on Solano at Key Route. The existing plaques are so faded that they are no longer legible. They would be replaced with bronze plaques. Albany Community Foundation and the Albany Firefighter's Association will be sharing the costs of paying for the plaques, and proposed that they would mount them as well. However, the Public Works Manager has reviewed the proposal and has requested that the City be responsible for the installation of the plaques.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated cost of the plaques is approximately \$2000 for both. This cost would be paid by the proposers. The City, at its request, would be responsible for mounting the plaques on the masonry wall.
