SUBJECT: Resolution No. 08-12 – A Resolution of the Albany City Council, State of California, Terminating Proclamation of Local Emergency

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Resolution No. 08-12, which terminates the Proclamation of Local Emergency.

BACKGROUND

On November 7, 2007, a container ship hit the Bay Bridge and released 58,000 gallons of bunker oil into the San Francisco Bay. On November 9, 2007, the Governor of California proclaimed a State of Emergency and on November 10, 2007, the City of Albany proclaimed a local emergency.

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to Government Code Section 863(d) the City Council is required to proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date. It has been determined that the conditions of the local emergency have abated so that services, personnel, equipment and facilities of the City are now sufficient to handle the conditions.
