SUBJECT: Gift to the City: Final Approval for Memorial Plaques Replacement Project by Albany Community Foundation and Albany FireFighters Association

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Accept the proposed Gift to City, with the provision that the City will be responsible for installation of the replacement plaques.

BACKGROUND

On March 3, 2008, Council approved a proposal from the Albany Community Foundation to replace the two faded plaques at the Veterans Memorial on Solano at Key Route. The existing plaques are so faded that they are no longer legible. They would be replaced with bronze plaques. The attached mock-ups show the final design for the plaques. The Albany Community Foundation and the Albany Firefighter's Association will be sharing the costs of paying for the plaques, and proposed that they would mount them as well. The City's Public Works Manager has reviewed the proposal and has recommended that the City be responsible for the installation of the plaques.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated cost of the plaques is approximately \$2,000. This cost would be paid by the proposers. The City, at its request, would be responsible for mounting the plaques on the masonry wall.
