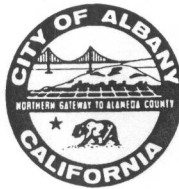

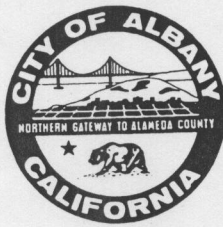
Some of the trees that would be impacted will be replaced in new bulb-outs proposed as part of this project. Street trees that may be removed are located along:

- Both sides of Marin Avenue between Cornell Avenue and San Pablo Avenue
- Southwest corner of San Pablo and Marin Avenue (Gill Tract)
- South side of Buchanan Street adjacent to Ocean View Elementary School and Ocean View Park

The Parks and Recreation Commission will determine which, if any, of these trees should be approved for a City Tree Removal Permit. Ultimately, the City Council will decide on this matter because of the nature of this City-sponsored project. A public meeting notice will be sent regarding that future meeting.

Notices will be placed on trees potentially affected by this action.

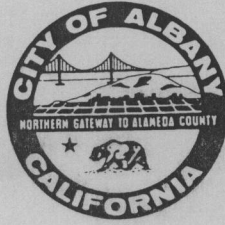
