Additional Costs

The City of Berkeley plan-check and EBRPD review revealed a number of additional costs

Additional Construction Costs	
2 additional catch basins and 149 feet of 12" SD pipe	\$ 13,132
Slope stabilization	26,250
Rock slope protection	9,000
Bollards at turn-around / emergency access point (south lot)	13,350
Total Additional Construction Costs	\$ 61,732
