Key Strategies for Action

Albany must embrace an integrated set of strategies to shape the future that its residents envision.

- To foster the development of young people and the community as a whole, Albany must continue to *prioritize education*. Albany youth will be encouraged and supported to contribute to their community in meaningful and innovative ways that benefit local and global sustainability. The city and community will endeavor to ensure that its schools meet the high expectations of residents and that young people are well prepared for the challenges ahead.
- To ensure the preservation of natural resources, Albany will *promote practices and decisionmaking that prioritize environmental sustainability*. The city will be bold in its efforts to adopt and support a wide range of efforts to conserve resources, develop alternative energy sources, and promote responsible transportation alternatives.
- To maintain Albany's quality of life and "small town feeling," the city and community will continue to *focus on pedestrian- and bike-friendly local transportation*, recognizing that such transportation simultaneously maintains the environment, strengthens the local economy, and builds community.
