Certifies that applicant or title holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project 25 consistent with the land tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so, and 26 4. Certifies that it will comply with the provisions of Section 1771.8 of the State Labor Code 27 regarding payment of prevailing wages on Projects awarded Proposition 50 Funds, and 28 29 5. If applicable, certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not

environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have been obtained, and  6. Certifies that applicant will work towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code Section 65041.1, and  7. Appoints the City Administrator, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
