BACKGROUND

City staff is proposing to apply for the Sustainable Communities Planning Grant (Prop 84) for partial funding for the preparation of a new General Plan.

DISCUSSION

The grant application would include funding for consultant services associated with preparation of a new General Plan. The grant application would coordinate with a variety of existing City goals and programs, including the recently adopted or accepted Climate Action Plan, Economic Development Strategies, Voices to Vision waterfront planning, and the Housing Element.

The grant application for the Sustainable Communities Planning Grant is due August 31, 2010, and a resolution is required.
