

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-56

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE CITY OF ALBANY MASTER FEE SCHEDULE BY ADDING A NEW FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A ONE-TIME EXCEPTION FOR ANY PERSON LIVING IN ALBANY BEFORE JULY 1, 2010 WHO OWNS AN OVERSIZED RECREATIONAL VEHICLE BEFORE JULY 1, 2010

WHEREAS, the Master Fee Schedule includes certain fees to be charged for various Administration, Community Development, Fire, Garbage and Recycling, General License and Business Regulation, Police and Parking, Recreation and Community Services, and Sewer and Storm Drain (Clean Water) permits and services; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2010, the City Council held a public hearing and approved the current master Fee Schedule in passing Resolution No. 2010-35; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City to establish fees and charges for City services that fully reimburse the City for the associated services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has enacted legislation regulating the on-street storage of oversized vehicles in adopting Ordinance No. 2010-02; and

WHEREAS, section 9-10.21 of the Albany Municipal Code provides for an exception for any person living in Albany before July 1, 2010 who owns an oversized recreational vehicle before July 1, 2010, for a period of up to five years; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council directed staff to develop a fee-based permit program to apply to the excepted oversized recreational vehicles; and

WHEREAS, police department staff has undertaken a study to determine the fair and equitable cost of providing this service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby amends the Master Fee Schedule (Resolution No. 2010-35) by adding the following to the Police Department Fees: Resident Oversized Vehicle Exception (AMC 9-10.21): \$100.
