12 Albany for a term of four (4) years; also that

15 **ROBERT ZWEBEN** was elected to the Office of City Attorney of the City of  
16 Albany for a term of one (1) year.

18 Pursuant to the State Education Code, Section 10515 the Albany Unified School  
19 District cancelled its election, as only three (3) people took out papers for three (3) seats.

21 The Albany Board of Education appointed the following three (3) people to the  
22 Board of Education:

23 **PAUL BLACK** was appointed to the Office of Board of Education for a term of  
24 four (4) years; and

26 **JONATHAN KNIGHT** was appointed to the Office of Board of Education for a  
27 term of four (4) years; and

1           **ALLAN MARIS** was appointed to the Office of Board of Education for a term of  
2 four (4) years.

3           **MEASURE N** on the ballot did receive the required vote, and therefore, was  
4 passed by the voters.

6           **MEASURE P** on the ballot did receive the required vote, and therefore, was  
7 passed by the voters.  
8

9           **MEASURE Q** on the ballot did receive the required vote, and therefore, was  
10 passed by the voters.

11           **MEASURE O** on the ballot did receive the required vote, and therefore, was  
12 passed by the voters.
