**SUBJECT:** City Council appointments to regional and local bodies

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Confirm any changes in appointments to regional commissions, committees, and boards.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Members of the City Council are appointed by the Mayor or Council to a variety of regional and local bodies. Those appointments are typically made by the Mayor and/or Council at a Council meeting following the City Council election. Certain appointments that are reserved for the mayor and vice mayor positions change automatically when there is a Council change in those positions.

#### **DISCUSSION**

There are two appointments that staff wishes to call to Council's attention:

<u>Pension Board:</u> The City Charter provides that the Mayor serves on the Pension Board, and if he/she is unable to serve, that the Mayor appoints one alternate. Mayor Javandel is unable to serve, and therefore he will need to appoint an alternate.

Berkeley-Albany Mental Health District Board: The City of Albany may submit two nominees to the Berkeley City Council for appointment to the Board; one of the nominees must be a mental health care recipient or the family member of a recipient. Mayor Wile has served as the Council appointee to the non-recipient seat for the past year. She is unable to continue to serve. The vacancy on the Board has been posted in accordinance with the Maddy Act. Ruth Cashmere, who has been a member of the Social & Economic Justice Commission, is interested in appointment.
