STAFF AND PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

That Council accept the gift offered by the Albany Rotary Club and Friends of Albany Library to make improvements to the tiles and paint a portion of the walls on the walkway leading to the entrance of the Community Center.

BACKGROUND

The Albany Rotary Club and the Friends of Albany Library would like to re-grout, clean, and reseal all tiles in need of such repair on the Marin Avenue walkway to the Community Center/Library building. Rotary would also like to paint portions of the wall in the garden area and walkway where the paint has peeled off.

The project was submitted the Public Works Manager for review. After a few questions and details regarding the project, the Public Works Manager agrees that the project may move forward. A licensed contractor will be completing the necessary work on the tiles. A project manager from the City will oversee the project.

SUSTAINABILITY IMPACT

The improvements add to the longevity of the walkway.
