

**RESOLUTION # 2011-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE  
SUBMITTAL AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAM PLAN APPLICATION  
FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY PARATRANSIT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR  
2011/12.**

**WHEREAS**, in November 2000 the voters of Alameda County approved the ½ cent sales tax through the passage of Measure B, re-approving the tax measure originally passed in 1986 and;

**WHEREAS**, the Alameda County Transportation Commission has responsibility in reviewing plans and administering an expected amount of \$4,846,816 in non-mandated funds from Measure B for “Special Transportation for Seniors and People with Disabilities” and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany will be receiving an estimated amount of \$25,555 for fiscal year 2011/12 and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany will implement Paratransit programs for seniors and people with disabilities such as a taxi subsidy, shopping trips, day trips and walking trips.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Albany City Council authorizes staff to submit and to implement the program plan application for fiscal year 2011/12 to the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority in the amount of \$25,555.
