

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING Of the CITY OF ALBANY TRAFFIC AND SAFETY COMMISSION

TO CONSIDER THE

PROPOSED LOCATION TO INSTALL TWO SPEED HUMPS ON THE 800 BLOCK OF CARMEL, TWO SPEED HUMPS ON THE 900 BLOCK OF CARMEL, AND ONE SPEED HUMP ON THE 900 BLOCK OF ORDWAY

THE MEETING WILL BE HELD ON:

Thursday, May 26, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. City Council Chambers-1000 San Pablo Avenue

The purpose of the meeting is to inform residents of these blocks of the proposed location of permanent speed humps. New City policy warrants installation of two speed humps on blocks longer than 450 feet. The 800 block of Carmel had a temporary speed hump fronting homes at 817, 823, and 818 Carmel that was removed in the fall of 2010. This feature will be replaced with a permanent one. A new permanent speed hump is proposed on this block fronting 844 and 845 residences on Carmel Avenue.

Two speed humps are proposed for the 900 Block of Carmel Avenue, fronting homes at 904,906, 907, and 922, 923 Carmel. Required signatures requesting these humps by 60% or more of the block residents have been received.

The temporary speed hump on the 900 block of Ordway Street was removed in the fall of 2010. This speed hump will be replaced where the temporary hump was located (fronting homes at 962 and 963 Ordway Street).

The permanent speed humps will be installed in the summer of 2011.
