6	WHEREAS, a benefits booklet outlines the benefits package provided to management and confidential employees; and

8	WHEREAS, management and confidential employees will begin contributing 4.0-4.5% of wages to CalPERS (California Public Employees Retirement System), and the Police Chief will begin contributing 9.0% of wages to CalPERS, effective July 11, 2011; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, non-safety management and confidential employees who are hired on or after July 26, 2011 will be enrolled in a lower-tier ("2% at 60") CalPERS program; and
11	
12	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the current educational reimbursement provision for management and confidential employees has a maximum benefit of \$750.00 per fiscal year, which is considerably less than the maximum benefit of \$2,000.00 per fiscal year for represented police employees.

15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BYTHE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL SERVICES JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY that the benefits booklet for management and confidential employees will be updated to describe the employee contributions to CalPERS as described above; to describe the lower-tier retirement formula described above; and, to increase the maximum education reimbursement to \$2,000.00 per fiscal year.
