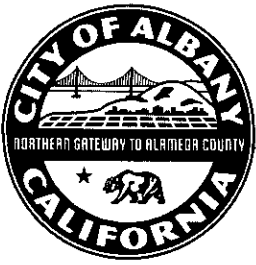
**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMING THE
DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT (INCLUDING AMENDMENT NO. 1) AND
LEVYING ASSESSMENTS IN LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING
ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1996-1 FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2011/12**

(Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972)

The Albany City Council resolves:

1. Pursuant to Chapter 3 of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the City Council directed Leptien, Cronin, Cooper, Morris & Poore, Inc., Engineer of Work of Assessment District No. 1996-1, to prepare and file an annual report for Fiscal Year 2011/12.
2. On May 10, 2011, the Engineer of Work filed his annual report, and the City Council adopted its resolution of intention to levy and collect assessments within the assessment district for Fiscal Year 2011/12. The City Council also set a public hearing to be held on June 20, 2011, in the meeting place of the City Council, 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, CA. Notice of the hearing was given in a time and manner required by law.
3. At the public hearing, the City Council opened the hearing, afforded every interested person an opportunity to make a protest to the annual report either in writing or orally, and the City Council considered each protest.
4. The City Council hereby confirms and finally approves the diagram and assessment, as set forth in the annual report of the Engineer of Work, including Amendment No. 1, and hereby levies the assessment set forth for Fiscal Year 2011/12.
