

RESOLUTION #2011-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL RATIFYING THE DECISION OF THE CITY MANAGER TO GRANT GHILOTTI CONSTRUCTION RELIEF FROM THEIR BID AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE PIERCE STREET PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AND SEGMENT I BIKEWAY TO REDGWICK CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,291,625.50 (CONTRACT NO. C11-3)

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2011, the City Council approved the construction plans and authorized the City Clerk to Advertise for Bids for the Pierce Street Pavement Rehabilitation and Segment I Bikeway (Contract No. C11-3); and,

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2011, the City Council authorized the City Manager to award a contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder; and,

WHEREAS, bid packages were prepared, the project was advertised for bids, and two (2) bids were received and publicly read on June 21, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by Ghilotti Construction of Santa Rosa, California and the second low bid was submitted by Redgwick Construction Company of Newark, California; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, Ghilotti Construction requested relief of their bid due to a mathematical error pursuant to the provisions of Section 5100 of the Public Contracts Code; and

WHEREAS, July 6, 2011, the City Engineer in consultation with the City Manager, issued a letter, rescinding a previous decision to re-bid this project, relieving Ghilotti Construction from their bid, and finding that the bid submitted by Redgwick Construction Company was the lowest responsive, responsible bid for this project; and

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2011, the City Manager issued a letter awarding the Contract for Pierce Street Pavement Rehabilitation and Segment I Bikeway (Contract No. C11-3) to Redgwick Construction in the amount bid of \$1,291,625.50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The City Council finds that the bid submitted by Redgwick Construction Company to be the lowest responsive, responsible bid for this project.
2. The City Council hereby ratifies the decision of the City Manager to award the Contract for Pierce Street Pavement Rehabilitation and Segment I Bikeway (Contract No. C11-3) to Redgwick Construction Company in the amount bid of \$1,291,625.50.
