A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING IMPROVEMENTS AS COMPLETE AND DIRECTING FILING OF THE NOTICE OF COMPLETION FOR CONTRACT NO. C10-22, BUCHANAN / JACKSON TRAFFIC SIGNAL & INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS. CALTRANS PROJECT No. SR2SL-5178(009)

WHEREAS, by agreement dated April 29, 2011, the City of Albany contracted with Mike Brown Electric Co. of Cotati, CA, to construct City of Albany Contract No. C10-22 (Buchanan/Jackson Traffic Signal & intersection Safety Improvements) and Caltrans Project No. SR2SL-5178(009), in accordance with the official plans and specifications prepared therefor, copies of which are on file in the Community Development Department offices; and,

WHEREAS, a Notice of Completion has been prepared, a copy of which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A," and included herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, an inspection of the project construction was completed on September 19, 2011, and at that time, all items were found to be complete and all work was found to be in compliance with the approved drawings and specifications.

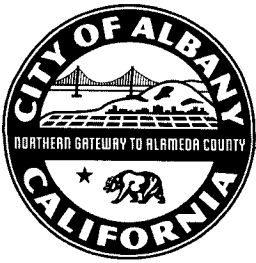
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED
