



### Watercolor Painting & Drawing

ADULTS

Open to all levels. Beginning students will work in watercolor, learning basics of watercolor painting, including mixing and applying washes, use of color, value, line, shape, form, light, rhythm and texture. Beginning students are shown specific exercises to learn color mixing and paint handling after which they work on subjects of their choice.

Advanced students can work in watercolor or their choice of any drawing/painting media, & instructor works with them individually. Basic drawing and composition will be taught to all. Students are encouraged to create visual richness by developing the thought and feeling in their work. Students should bring supplies they already have to the first class. Materials will be discussed and list handed out at first class. Students supply their own paint, brushes and paper. \$4 material fee paid to instructor.

### Multi-cultural Textile Art

ADULTS

Learn the basics of ethnic handwork (embroidery, appliqué, reverse appliqué, piecing, etc.) and then turn this knowledge into wearable art or something unique for your home. Recycle a jean jacket or pants and by adding embroidery and/or appliqué you have a "hot" looking casual garment. Make one-of-a-kind pillows, tote or hand bag, wall hanging, kimono, etc. Visit the first class wherein you may start, for process, a small project and bring along at least 5 coordinating pieces of plain and print fabric, dressmaker pins, a yard of unbleached muslin and sharp scissors. Beginning and advanced students welcome.

Tools and equipment will be discussed during the first class including what and where to buy brushes, paint, support, etc. Bring to first class those art supplies you may have on hand as well as a drawing pad and a drawing tool of your choice (pencil, charcoal, pen, crayons, etc.). No art or drawing experience can be an asset.

### Drawing with Pen, Ink & Brush

ADULTS

Open to all levels. Pen, ink and brush are an inexpensive, versatile, easy-to-use drawing media that can resemble an intricate line drawing etching or a painting in black and white. Beginning students will work in drawing with pen, ink and brush. Techniques such as free-flowing pen and brush lines and shading with cross-hatching, stippling, and wash to achieve a range of values on the gray scale will be taught using a variety of approaches and exercises.

Advanced students or those who have taken a class with Stephanie can work in their choice of any drawing or painting media, with instructor working with them individually. Students will supply their own pens, ink, brushes and lightweight paper. The instructor will supply special paper, other materials and will contact students regarding supplies. \$4 material fee paid to instructor.
