7-1. UC Village Project – prepare recommendation to City Council regarding project

The Committee developed and unanimously approved the following resolution: The City of Albany Sustainability Committee generally supports the proposed University Village Mixed Use Development Project, but asks that the developer address item TL-3.3 of the City's Climate Action Plan to evaluate the greenhouse gas emissions associated with the development and other mitigations to offset the impact on the City's carbon footprint and implementation of the CAP. Additionally, we ask that safe, convenient solutions be identified to facilitate access for pedestrian, bicycle and other alternative modes of transportation. The Sustainability Committee also asks that the developer identify ways to offset the project's identified impact on greenhouse gas emissions, including how the project can help facilitate implementation of the City's Climate Action Plan and help offset the City's overall carbon footprint.

7-2. Community engagement process regarding proposal for second campus of Lawrence Berkeley National Lab on Golden Gate Fields property – receive update and identify how the Committee can participate in the process

Jeff Bond provided an update regarding the planning process. A task force will be created for the City including members from the Council and Committees/Commissions. A member from the Committee will be appointed.
