STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Advisory Bodies are not precluded from addressing other items relevant to their charge as they arise, however the items outlined on the work plans are intended to help guide the efforts of the group and increase community awareness regarding the particular focus areas of each Advisory Body. The remaining Advisory

Bodies will be developing their work plans at their upcoming meetings, and will be scheduled for the City Council shortly thereafter.
