4       **A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE**  
5       **INITIAL STUDY-MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE**  
6       **CITY OF ALBANY ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

8           **WHEREAS**, the City of Albany has prepared a Active Transportation Plan  
9       (ATP); and

10  
11           **WHEREAS**, the Active Transportation Plan is defined as a “project” under the  
12       California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and is thus subject to environmental  
13       review; and

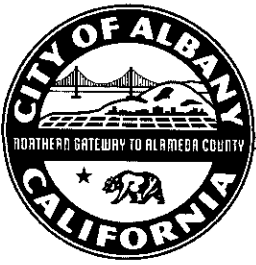

15           **WHEREAS**, the proposed ATP includes numerous policies, strategies and  
16       measures for improving the City’s bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure; and

18           **WHEREAS**, the City retained the consulting firm Fehr & Peers and sub  
19       consultant Questa Engineering to prepare an Initial Study of the proposed Active  
20       Transportation Plan and determined that the ATP will not have a significant effect on the  
21       environment; and

23           **WHEREAS**, CEQA does not require a detailed evaluation of all projects that  
24       could conceivably be developed consistent with Active Transportation Plan policies but  
25       rather requires the City to conduct project-level environmental review for subsequent  
26       projects, as appropriate; and
