WHEREAS, the committed teachers have decades of experience nurturing children and their families, including the current teachers and directors Tara Gray, Susy Bernos, Cindy Lee, and Nighat Nasim who continue to be a source of guidance, comfort, and love; and

WHEREAS, while years have passed since the school's start in 1937, the preschool's cooperative spirit, strong sense of community, and commitment to play remain the same; and

WHEREAS, the success of the preschool has depended on staying true to the values of cooperation, community and commitment to play; and

WHEREAS, the preschool depends on 100% participation from families to help run, lead, and grow the school, investing time and resources to foster early childhood education and life-long learning; and

WHEREAS, Albany Preschool is deserving of special recognition for its continued service to generations of preschoolers and their families.
