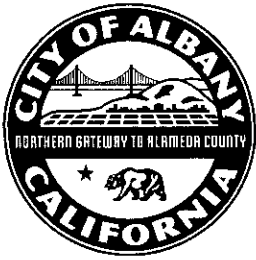

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby sets the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays at 7:30 p.m. as the regular meeting dates for the Planning & Zoning Commission beginning August 2012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, subject to the requirements of the California Government Code and the Albany Municipal Code, the Community Development Director may schedule special meetings of the Planning & Zoning Commission at any time, and may adjust the meeting location due to schedule conflicts or capacity limitations with the use of the City Council Chambers.
