**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY IN THE AMOUNT OF APPROXIMATELY \$29,000.00.**


**WHEREAS**, the California Office of Traffic Safety's (OTS) mission is to effectively and efficiently administer traffic safety grant funds to reduce traffic deaths, injuries, and economic loss; and

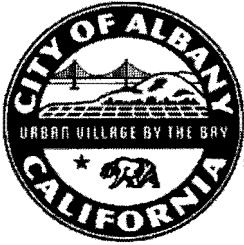
**WHEREAS**, the Albany Police Department desires to continue its concentrated traffic enforcement strategies that support OTS and the Department's philosophy of proactive law enforcement;

**WHEREAS**, the Albany City Council recognizes that hazardous driving behaviors, such as aggressive, distracted, and impaired driving pose unnecessary risk and cause unnecessary pain, suffering and property damage within our community; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council recognizes that traffic safety throughout the City of Albany can be improved if these unsafe driving behaviors are addressed through a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a grant agreement with the California Office of Traffic Safety entitled "Selective Traffic Enforcement Program" in an amount of approximately \$29,000.
