Proposed Green Building Ordinance Revisions

The key changes include:

- Increase the minimum point standards for Planning Application requests (both administrative & Planning & Zoning Commission review)
 - O Lower the incentive points and increase the point minimum
 - O Currently the minimum is 50 points.
- Create a template for Build It Green to be included on Building Permit plans
- Have an inspection for Build it Green Compliance prior to the final inspection
 - o Collect a deposit (\$200 est.) for the inspection at time of permit fee collection
 - Work with a Certified Build it Green Inspector to conduct the final compliance inspection

Additional changes include changing the new commercial construction threshold to 10,000 sq. ft. for official LEED certification and allowing equivalency for renovation/construction more than 5,000 sq. ft. The revised improvement table with Commission feedback is included below.
