## A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has identified the need for a more efficient, flexible and varied fleet; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed our best leasing and purchasing options which included review of vendor vehicle leasing and comparison to costs and found the lowest life cycle costs, greatest benefit and most fleet flexibility came from a lease option with Enterprise Fleet Management; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Albany desires to expedite deployment of low-emission vehicles among the City's municipal fleet; and

WHEREAS, vehicle leasing offers an opportunity to achieve Climate Action Strategies outlined in the City of Albany's Climate Action plan without incurring the high initial capital costs associated with vehicle purchase; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Fleet Management will provide an economical price and greater depth of service than competitors;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Albany does hereby authorize the City Manager or her/his designee to enter into a master lease agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management and the cost of that agreement shall fall within each of the City departments' budget as approved by the City Council.
