Enterprise Fleet Management; and

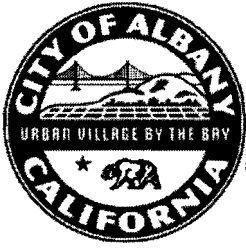
WHEREAS, the City of Albany desires to expedite deployment of low-emission
