A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF NEW AMBULANCE WITH FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ASSISTANCE FIREFIGHTERS GRANT AWARD AND LOCAL FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Albany Fire Department received a grant award through the Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program in the amount of \$135,938 for the purchase of an ambulance in March 2013; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2013, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2013-11 accepting the grant award; and

WHEREAS, Fire Department staff has researched the various options, manufacturers and their designs to develop an ambulance to best serve the citizens of Albany for the next 15 years; and

WHEREAS, the current fleet includes a 2005 Ford E350 ambulance, and a 14 year old Ford E450 reserve ambulance; and

WHEREAS, the 14 year old Ford E450 reserve ambulance will be replaced by the new ambulance; and

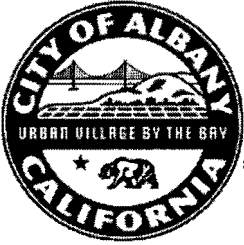
WHEREAS, the City's local match and funding requirement to purchase the new ambulance totals \$60,859.00, which will be funded from equipment reserves,

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the purchase of a new ambulance with funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance Firefighters Grant Award and local funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Emergency Vehicle Group, INC. or Horton / Leader Emergency Vehicles, INC. for a new 2014 Terrastar ambulance for the amount not to exceed \$190,000, with delivery by January 1, 2014.
