

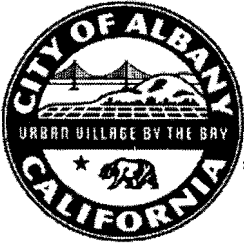
**WHEREAS,** FOAS submitted a request in writing to the Interim City Manager to install a memorial bench in the garden of the Senior/Youth Annex.
