WHEREAS, Resolution No.96-3 established the City Council Policies and Administrative Procedures Manual, and revised again on August 23, 2000;

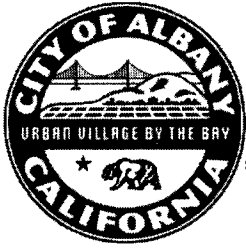
