A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT FOR ONE FIRE COMMAND VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has identified the need for a more efficient, flexible and varied fleet; and

WHEREAS, the fire department has developed a plan to modernize and maintain the emergency vehicle fleet through a lease agreement when beneficial; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed our best leasing and purchasing options which included review of vendor vehicle leasing from Enterprise Fleet Management used by the City, and found the lowest life cycle costs, greatest benefit and most fleet flexibility came from a lease option with Enterprise Fleet Management; and

WHEREAS, Enterprise Fleet Management provides an economical price and benefit compared to purchasing the vehicle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Albany does hereby authorize the City Manager or her designee to enter into a master lease agreement with Enterprise Fleet Management to lease one (1) emergency command vehicle at an annual cost of \$8,331 as presented in the Staff Report provided to the City Council April 7, 2014.
