A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITIZEN'S OPTIONS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY (COPS) FUNDING TO PURCHASE AND UPFIT TWO FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR UTILITY VEHICLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,456.00

WHEREAS, the State COPS grant program provides money to local police agencies for the purpose of enhancing public safety by supporting front line law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Police Department has identified a need to replace two Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors with the purchase of specialized police vehicles to fulfill its policing mission; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2013-14 budget does not contain funding for the purchase of two (2) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles; and

WEREAS, contract #1-12-23-14, is a cooperative purchasing contract with the State of California, Department of General Services, Procurement Division, which allows for local government agencies to benefit from the state competitive bidding and vendor selection process; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department can utilize State Contract #1-12-23-14 for the purchase of two new Ford Police Interceptor utility vehicles from Folsom Lake Ford; and

WEREAS, Albany Municipal Code §2-27.2 authorizes the City to use said cooperative purchasing contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the purchase of two (2) Ford Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles under State of California procurement contract #1-12-23-14, and upfitting those vehicles to ready them for patrol service, utilizing COPS Program grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$70,456.00.
