A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY IN THE AMOUNT OF APPROXIMATELY \$69,685


WHEREAS, the California Office of Traffic Safety's (OTS) mission is to effectively and efficiently administer traffic safety grant funds to reduce traffic deaths, injuries, and economic loss; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Police Department desires to continue its concentrated traffic enforcement strategies that support OTS and the Department's philosophy of proactive law enforcement; and

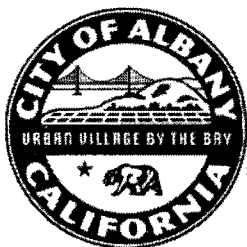
WHEREAS, the Albany City Council recognizes that hazardous driving behaviors, such as aggressive, distracted, and impaired driving pose unnecessary risk and cause unnecessary pain, suffering and property damage within our community; and

WHEREAS, City Council recognizes that traffic safety throughout the City of Albany can be improved if these unsafe driving behaviors are addressed through a Selective Traffic Enforcement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a grant agreement with the California Office of Traffic Safety entitled "Selective Traffic Enforcement Program" in an amount of approximately \$69,685.
