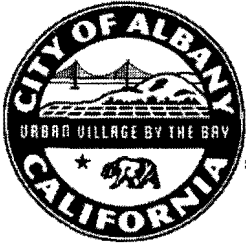
**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE
EXTENSION OF THE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT
INNOVATION (INN) GRANT CONTRACT #9009B WITH THE CITY OF
BERKELEY FOR THE SENIOR 2 SENIOR PROGRAM UNTIL JUNE 30,
2015 WITH ADDITIONAL FUNDING TOTALING \$31,257**

WHEREAS, based on the passage of Proposition 63 in 2004, a funding allocation has been made available by the State to the City of Berkeley for the purpose of Innovation Programming; and

WHEREAS, all MHSA Innovation funds are to be utilized to expand and transform the mental health service delivery system to better meet the needs of consumers, family members and under-served populations; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2012 the Albany Senior Center was awarded a MHSA Innovation (INN) grant by the City of Berkeley in the amount of \$49,999 to implement services necessary for planning and implementing a Senior 2 Senior program which consists of weekly support groups that provide access to, education on, and support around new phone and computer technologies for Albany/Berkeley Senior Citizens; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2013, the City of Berkeley authorized the amendment of the MHSA Innovation (INN) contract for the Senior 2 Senior program to extend the length of the contract to June 30, 2014 and additional funding in the amount of \$45,000 bringing total funding received to \$94,999; and
