A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE ALAMEDA COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES AGENCY – AREA AGENCY ON AGING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015.

WHEREAS, The City of Albany has been receiving funding from the Alameda County Social Services Agency- Area Agency on Aging for the provision of services, activities and programs to older adults since 1993;and

WHEREAS, for the first four (4) years, the funding was for Information & Assistance. Beginning with fiscal year 1997-1998, the funding was provided for Community Services/Senior Center Management, which is now called Senior Center Activities; and

WHEREAS, the Area Agency on Aging (AAA) manages contracts from a variety of federal funding streams, including Older Americans Act programs, Health Insurance Counseling & Assistance Program, and the Senior Community Employment Program; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the AAA manages the Senior Injury Prevention Program contracts (funded through Measure A), contracts for Adult Protective Services, and several contracts for services for seniors that are funded through the County’s general fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved a number of the County General Fund Contracts on May 27, 2014, one of which was the contract with the City of Albany in the amount of \$18,909; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has been receiving funding from the Alameda County Social Services Agency- Area Agency on Aging for over 10 years and the funding received is

1 used to fund part of the salary of the Community and Human Services Manager which supervises
2 the operations, program, services and activities at the Albany Senior Center; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Albany Senior Center provides a comprehensive array of recreational
5 programs and services that meet the needs of older adults in the community to enhance quality of
6 life and help seniors to remain active, healthy and independent and serves approximately 2,800
7 adults over the age of 50 on a monthly basis; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the center offers classes such as literature, yoga, memoir writing,
10 watercolor and Zumba Gold, has very popular Day Trip and hiking programs, offers essential
11 food assistance services such as a daily congregate dinner and a Meals on Wheels program;

13 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Albany City Council authorizes
14 the City Manager to enter into a contract with the Alameda County Social Services
15 Agency – Area Agency on Aging for Fiscal Year 2014-2015.
