A. UC Mixed Use Development Project Update and Discussion of GHG Emissions Report

Jeff Bond provided an update – The Planning & Zoning Commission has approved the Belmont Village project. The committee discussed the GHG emissions analysis and asked that the development team demonstrate the economics of the measures they chose and provide an analysis of the barriers to adding more PV. Staff will invite the development team to attend the January meeting.

B. Marin Clean Energy CCA Update

Claire Griffing provided an update – The MCE Board approved moving forward with a membership analysis for Albany at their December 5th meeting but will be reopening the discussion of governance for affiliate members.

C. Arts and Green Festival Update

Chair Cooper provided an update – The Arts Committee voted to be a part of the event and help with planning. Miles Williams of the Albany Arts Gallery is also helping plan the event.

D. Schools Subcommittee Update and Discussion of Committee Role in Planning Process for AUSD Facilities

Committee Member Blanchard provided an update – He has been attending steering committee meetings, where they have been discussing the replacement of Ocean View and Marin Elementary Schools. There is a short timeline for the planning process in order to access state funding. He asked if the committee could speak to the merits of new construction vs. repurposing/retrofitting buildings but committee members didn't feel they had enough information to make a recommendation at this time.

E. Outreach Subcommittee Update and Discussion of Green Coalition Meeting Proposal

The Committee discussed the Green Coalition meeting proposal and suggested edits.
