Staff recommendation: that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2014-75 – A Resolution of the Albany City Council Providing for the Appointment to the Offices of this City that were to be Elected on Tuesday, November 4, 2014

Assistant City Manager/City Clerk Nicole Almaguer delivered the staff report. The nomination period for prospective candidates for the Office of City Council opened on July 14 and closed on August 8, 2014. A total of two candidates qualified for the Office of City Council 4-year term. The nomination for the Office of City Council 2-year term was extended to August 13, 2014 per the Elections Code as the incumbent did not file for this particular seat. At the close of the extended nomination period, one candidate qualified for the Office of City Council 2-year term.

Per the Elections Code the Council has the authority to cancel the election and appoint the qualified candidates to the seats if there are an equal number of candidates to seats. The Council may also choose to have the election. If appointed, the appointees are considered to be the same as being elected, and will be sworn in at a Special Meeting on December 8, 2014.
