## A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE 100% PLANS, AUTHORIZING THE CALL FOR BIDS, AND ALLOCATING UP TO \$1,144,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE 1 OF PEIRCE STREET PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Albany purchased a 4.5 acre parcel on Pierce Street in June 2011 from Caltrans for the purpose of developing a park, pedestrian/bike trail, and maintenance center; and

WHEREAS, since the acquisition, staff has been working with consultants, the community, as well as a number of the City's Commission and Committees to develop plans for the construction of the park; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2012, options regarding the plans were presented to Council and Council supported a number of ideas including a phased approach to the project; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2013, Council approved the development of phase 1 of the park; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2013, Council approved the 35% plans and directed staff to complete the 65% plans; and

WHEREAS, the 65% plans were approve by Council on April 21, 2014 and Council directed staff to complete the plans;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby approves the 100% plans for Pierce Street Park on September 15, 2014; and
