## **BACKGROUND**

The City has received the attached memo from Union City Mayor Green requesting City Councils in Alameda County to adopt the attached resolution. The issue relates to a proposed Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) policy change regarding priorities for transit projects transit projects eligible for Regional Measure 2 (\$1 bridge toll) funding, and the concern that the change will lower the funding priority and timing for the Dumbarton Rail project.

MTC's Programming and Allocations Committee is scheduled to make a recommendation on the matter to the full Commission on July 9, 2008.
