WHEREAS, the purpose of this report is to assist the City with evaluating pavement conditions and identifying the most cost effective maintenance priorities specific to its needs based on a scale known as the pavement condition index (PCI); and

**WHEREAS**, in order for the City to be eligible for MTC funds, the PMP report has to be re-certified every two years.

WHEREAS, based on the PMP report, the current average PCI for Albany's streets is 56 (fair);

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Albany City Council hereby approves the 2015 Pavement Management Program Update Report.
