WHEREAS, on April 7, 2014, pursuant to Chapter 3 of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (Streets and Highways Code Section 22620), the Council approved Resolutions #2014-33 and #2014-34 directing NBS to prepare the annual reports, for three consecutive years, concerning the levy and collection of assessments within the assessment districts for LLAD No. 1988-1 and 1996-1; and

WHEREAS, On June 1, 2015 the Council adopted Resolutions #2015-26 initiating proceedings, Resolutions #2015-28 preliminarily approving the Engineer's Report for FY 2015/16, and Resolution #2015- 30 declaring the Intention of the Council to levy and collect assessments, and setting July 6, 2015 as the date for the public hearing for each District in the meeting place of the City Council, 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, CA; and

WHEREAS, in the report of the Engineer, assessments are not proposed to increase over the amount for the previous year; and

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing was given in the time and manner required by law; and


WHEREAS, at the public hearing held on July 6, 2015, the City Council afforded every interested person an opportunity to make a protest to the annual report either in writing or orally, and the City Council considered each protest;

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby confirms the diagram and assessment, as set forth in the annual report of the Engineer of Work for the 2015/16 fiscal year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby levies the assessments as set forth in the report of the Engineer for fiscal year 2015/16; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is authorized and directed to immediately file the Engineer's Report for Assessment District No. 1988-1 for the 2015/16 fiscal year together with a certified copy of this resolution with the Alameda County Auditor.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT ASSESSMENTS FOR THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1988-1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015/16

The City Council (the "Council") of the City of Albany (the "City") does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Council previously completed its proceedings in accordance with and pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500) (the "Act") to establish the City's Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District No. 1988-1 (the "Assessment District"); and

WHEREAS, the City has retained NBS for the purpose of assisting with the annual levy of the Assessment District, and the preparation and filing of an Annual Report.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Intention: The Council hereby declares its intention to levy and collect assessments within the Assessment District to pay the costs of the improvements for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016. The Council finds that the public's best interest requires such action.

2. Improvements: The Improvements include, but are not limited to: turf, shrubs, plants and trees, landscaping, irrigation and drainage systems, graffiti removal, and associated appurtenances within the public right-of-ways or specific easements. Services provided include all necessary service, operations, administration and maintenance required to keep the improvements in a healthy, vigorous, and satisfactory condition.

3. Assessment District Boundaries: The boundaries of the Assessment District are as shown by the assessment diagram filed in the offices of the City Clerk, which map is made a part hereof by reference.

4. Annual Report: Reference is made to the Annual Report prepared by NBS, on file with the Clerk, for a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the Assessment District and the zones therein, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the Assessment District.

5. Notice of Public Hearing: The Council hereby declares its intention to conduct a Public Hearing concerning the levy of assessments in accordance with Section 22629 of the Act. All objections to the assessment, if any, will be considered by the Council. The Public Hearing will be held on **Monday, July 6, 2015 at 7:30 pm** or as soon thereafter as is feasible in the Council Chambers located at 1000 San Pablo Avenue, Albany, CA 94706. The Council further orders the Clerk to publish notice of this resolution in accordance with Section 22626 of the Act.

6. Increase of Assessment: The maximum assessment is not proposed to increase from the previous year above that previously approved by the property owners (as "increased assessment" is defined in Section 54954.6 of the Government Code).

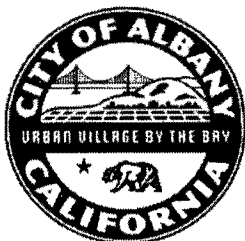
