Five Areas Where Your Actions Make a Major Difference



- 1. Bicycle, BART or bus.
- 2. If you must drive, carpool or Rideshare.
- 3. When purchasing a car, choose a hybrid or one that runs on biofuels.
- 4. Keep your engine running efficiently with regular tune ups, oil changes, air filter replacements, and proper tire inflation.
- 5. Vacation closer to home and telecommute when you can.
- 6. Group errands together.
- 7. Drive less aggressively.







Avoid Driving

- 1. Replace incandescent bulbs with compact fluorescent lights.
- 2. If you're buying appliances, go for energy efficient appliances (look for the Energy Star label).
- 3. Turn off lights, computers, electronics, and small appliances when you're not using them. Unplug appliances or plug them into a power strip that you switch
- 4. Improve your home's insulation.
- 5. Insulate your water heater or install a tankless water heater.
- 6. Turn down your thermostat.
- 7. Hand-dry dishes and hang-dry laundry.
- 8. Consider installing solar panels.





- 1. Reuse or repair rather than replace.
- 2. Use a reusable water bottle, to-go mug or thermos, canvas shopping bag, napkin, etc.
- 3. Don't take home any new plastic bags, and reuse what you already have.
- 4. Use rechargeable batteries.
- 1. Recycle bottles, cans, and paper.
- 2. Compost yard trim and kitchen waste.
- 3. Take items with heavy metals, poisons or pollutants to a hazardous waste facility.
- 4. Properly dispose of batteries, computers, light bulbs, and other electronics. State regulations ban these items from your regular trash. Check StopWaste.org for disposal locations.
