6 was submitted to the City by Sheri Wong on August 3, 2015; and
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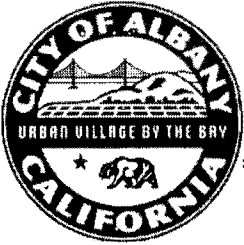
8 **WHEREAS**, per Albany Municipal Code Section 2-32, "Gifts and Donations to the
9 City", the Council adopted Resolution No. 04-06, establishing procedures for acceptance
10 of gifts. Per the procedure, the City Manager shall review memorial bench and plaque
11 applications before an application can go before the Parks and Recreation Commission;

14 **WHEREAS**, the City Manager approved the application being considered and the
15 Parks and Recreation Commission reviewed the application on September 10, 2015,
16 recommending approval by the City Council; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the request is to place a memorial bench and plaque in Memorial Park
19 near the toddler playground, a location selected by the family of Caleb and approved by
20 the Parks and Recreation Commission.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Albany City Council hereby
22 accepts the gift to the City of a memorial bench and plaque in memory of Caleb.
