**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AGREEMENT
WITH VISION INTERNET TO COMPLETE A WEBSITE REDESIGN
AND UPGRADE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000**

WHEREAS, the City of Albany's website was first launched in 1996 and its underlying infrastructure has not been updated since 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany's website is an essential communication tool that provides quality information and government transparency; and

WHEREAS, the City's website software is out of date, has limited compatibility with web browsers, lacks key functionality to adequately serve the community, was built for primarily computer use and is extremely slow for staff to update; and

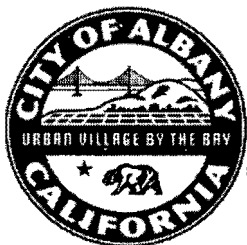
WHEREAS, this upgrade will improve user experiences on mobile devices, keep the City's site compatible technological changes and optimize staff and resident's experiences; and

WHEREAS, the redesign and upgrade of the City's website is supported by the City of Albany IT Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract not to exceed \$40,000 with Vision Internet to complete a website redesign and upgrade.
