WHEREAS, the current City Standard Details were issued in 2009 providing guidance for public infrastructure design, construction, inspection, and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, in review of the current City Standard Details, City Staff found issues including inaccurate or erroneous information; non-compliant standards with current federal, state, and county standards; inconsistent and out-of-date details from outside agencies; and lacking of new standards to implement City public works programs; and

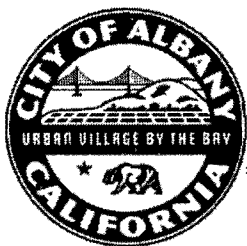
WHEREAS, in updating the City Standard Details, City staff has made corrections to various standard details; consolidated standard details from outside agencies including Alameda County, and Caltrans; updated standard details in compliance with current best practices; and expanded new standard details for implementation of public works program; and
