CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Mass called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Maass led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

3. STUDY SESSION

3-1. Draft General Plan Study Session

The Council held a study session to review the draft General Plan

Community Development Director Jeff Bond provided an overview and introduced Consultant Barry Miller who provided a presentation to the Council regarding the Draft General Plan. The goal is to adopt a final General Plan in Spring 2016. Once adopted, the General Plan can be amended up to four times per year.

The following people spoke: Delia Carol; Malcolm Russell; Julie Wakelee-Lynch; Kevin Omi; Alexa Hauser; Jerri Holan.

A summary of comments is as follows: encouraged further measures to minimize automobile traffic, improve accessibility to the waterfront, link land use and conservation/sustainability elements; encouraged more contingency planning in the General Plan such as climate change impacts, increased population density; include affordable housing as a top priority for any development intended on the Golden Gate Fields property and/or financing to establish affordable housing at a different location in Albany, and with any changes proposed to Measure C for

development at the waterfront; encouraged revenue from any sale of Golden Gate Fields to provide an affordable housing fund; encouraged including language regarding removing parking as a barrier to developing affordable housing; historic resources within Albany should be further protected to ensure preservation of historical sites, and a historic zoning ordinance should be adopted.

The Council provided feedback regarding the draft General Plan including areas for clarification and further detail.
