RESOLUTION NO. 2016-9

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE CITY OF ALBANY MASTER FEE SCHEDULE TO INCLUDE A PARKING FINE OF \$45 FOR VIOLATIONS OF ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 9-10.14.

WHEREAS, Chapter IX of the Albany Municipal Code provides regulations for motor vehicles and traffic within the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2015 the Albany City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2015 - 02 adding section 9-10.14 to Chapter IX of the Albany Municipal Code establishing regulations for parking of vehicles in waterfront areas within the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2015-02 implemented two-hour parking time limits and a prohibition on all parking between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. in Albany's Waterfront Areas; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2015-41 established the current Master Fee Schedule to include fine amounts for violations of select Albany Municipal Code sections; and

WHEREAS, when adopted, Resolution No. 2015-41 did not designate the fine for violations of section 9-10.14 of the Albany Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code section 1-9 requires bail for violations of the code be set by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2016, the City Council held a public hearing and the proposed amendment to the Master Fee Schedule was posted and available at least 10 days prior to the hearing;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby approves the addition of a \$45 fine to the Master Fee Schedule for violations of section 9-10.14 of the Albany Municipal Code, effective immediately.
